All Valleyview Skating Club Skaters are invited to participate in our spring show – CanSkate, CanPowerSkate, Junior Star, Primary, Intermediate, Senior, and Master Skaters!

THEME/TITLE

This year's show will be entitled "Circus Dreams on Ice"

REHEARSALS

ALL REHEARSALS MUST BE ATTENDED. We will begin rehearsals the week of March 9th at Valleyview Arena and continue through to March 26th. Mandatory practices will be March 9-12th and March 23rd-27th. Each Star Level group will rehearse at least ONCE a day (Monday-Thursday) as well as some practices during the Spring break week. These are not mandatory for those who have travel plans already for the 16th-19th.

CanSkate/CanPower will rehearse 2-4 times per week. Exact dates and times of these practices will be forthcoming.

Solos will have their own times given during these rehearsal weeks.

DRESS REHEARSAL

Dress rehearsal will be on Friday, March 27th 330-530 pm (same day as Ice Show) at Mc Arthur Arena. This is your final practice and is MANDATORY! Please have children wear their full costume to dress rehearsal. All skaters will be allowed to watch the show during dress rehearsal.

COST

CANSKATE & POWER - \$75.00 (includes costume and extra ice time)

JUNIOR STAR/PRIMARY/INTERMEDIATE/SENIOR GROUP NUMBERS - \$125.00

ADDITIONAL SOLO/DUET/TRIO - \$35.00

The ice show fees are non-refundable and must be paid online before Nov. 30th, 2019.

Winter Session Canskate/ CanPower skaters fee payment deadline is January 17, 2020.

REGISTERING ON LINE

Log in to our online registration system and go to "PROGRAMS". Scroll to the category your skater is in to register them for the show.

- CanSkate – register for "CanSkate Show 2020" at the bottom of the CanSkate list
- PowerSkate – "PowerSkate Show 2020" is at the bottom of the PowerSkate List

- Junior Star, Primary, Intermediate, Senior, Master – register for “Star Skater Show 2020” at the bottom of the “OPEN” list
- Any Star Skaters will most likely be in one group number and a solo/trio/duet number. Please register for the GROUP number right away so we can plan who will be participating to then hand out solo/duet/trio's.

COSTUMES

We will be happy to take your child's measurements for costumes anytime when class lessons are being offered beginning Monday, January 6 through Friday, January 17, 2020. If the child is on the borderline of a costume size, we will choose the next larger size. If alterations are needed you will be responsible for your own seamstress and all alteration costs. Ice show costumes cannot be exchanged or returned.
